How to come to Sultanahmet region?

From Atatürk Airport:

Using HAVAŞ / HAVATAŞ shuttle services it can be reached to Sultanahmet Square.

Airport Subway → Aksaray station → Tramvay → Sultanahmet Square.

or

Airport Subway → Yenikapı station → Marmaray → Sirkeci Station → Tramvay → Sultanahmet Square.

From Sabiha Gökçen Airport:

Using HAVAŞ / HAVATAŞ shuttle services it can be reached to Taksim → Funicular → Kabataş Tram → Sultanahmet Square.

From Sabiha Gökçen bus number e11 is the easiest way to come Kadıköy, from here you can use Eminonu ferry and then with tramvay to Sultanahmet Square.

With Km20, KM22 and e10 → Kartal Subway → Ayrılık Çeşmesi Station → Marmaray → Sirkeci Station → Tramvay → Sultanahmet Square.

4. PUBLIC TRANSPORT

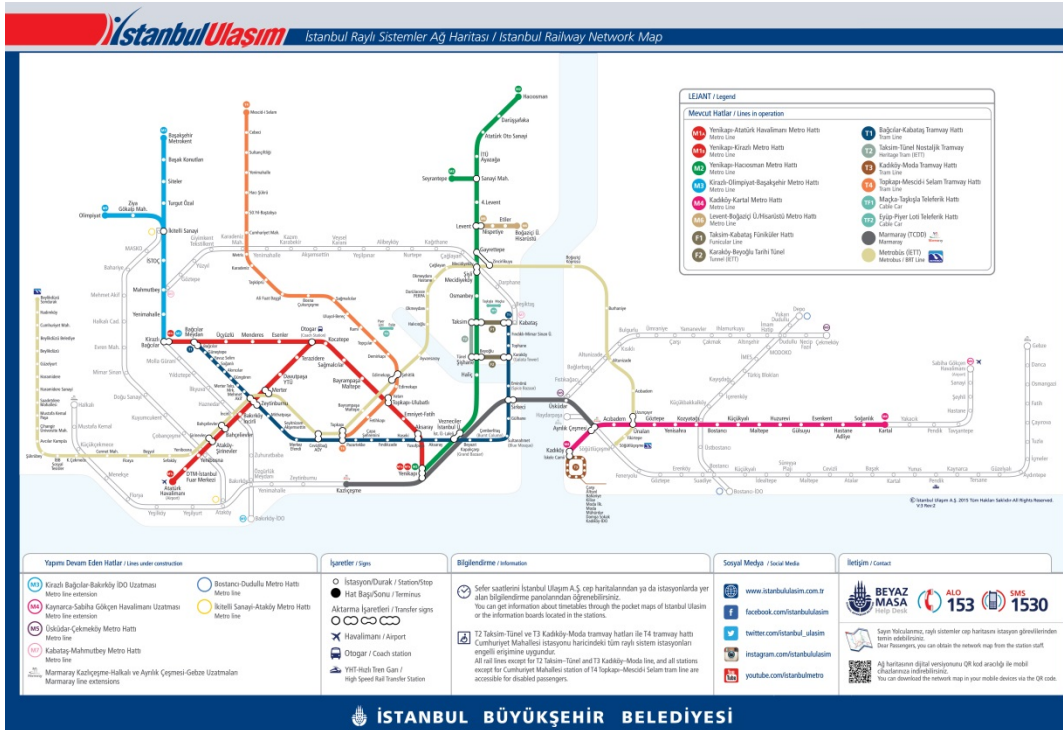
Istanbul has an excellent transportation system; you can find nearly all forms of transport as buses, subways, trams, funiculars, ferries, metro buses, sea taxis and sea boats. Almost all of them are linked to one another.

If you buy ISTANBULKART and load money in it, you can use it when you change transport.
